





Thatcher urged 'let Liverpool decline' after 1981 riots

Margaret Thatcher was secretly urged to consider abandoning Liverpool to a fate of "managed decline" after the Toxteth riots in 1981, official papers reveal.

Government files released under the 30-year rule show senior Tory ministers urged her not to spend public money on the "stony ground" of Merseyside.

The then prime minister's Chancellor Sir Geoffrey Howe said it would be like "trying to make water flow uphill".

The riots in Toxteth, Liverpool, on 3 July, triggered unrest across England.

Cultural Revolution:

City's 800th birthday Opening Liverpool One 2008 Capital of Culture 2008

- The ECoC generated an additional 1.14m overnight stays
- 2008 there were an estimated **28m** visits to Liverpool
- 2018 38m visitors came to the city, with an increase in the number of staying visitors, up to 2.7m.
- 2017 foreign tourism brings in £358m to the local economy

2008 - Liverpool had 37 hotels and guesthouses with a total of 3,481 bedrooms rising to 67 in 2017

2022 - 97 hotels and 29 hotel chains in Liverpool with over 10,000 bedrooms

A municipal perspective




The cultural sector is a key part of the Visitor Economy and is delivering considerable social impact through its programmes

By 2009

- 66% of Liverpool residents took part in at least one ECoC event
- 14% of Liverpool residents felt they had 'tried something new' in 2008
- 60% of North West residents considered that by 2008 there were more cultural activities and opportunities in the region than previously


